I. Solving Linear Systems Graphically. Solve each system by graphing on a graphing calculator.

<p>1. $\begin{cases} y = \frac{4}{5}x + 2 \\ 3x - 4y = -7 \end{cases}$</p> <p>$y = (\frac{4}{5})x + 2$</p> <p>$-4y = -3x - 7$</p> <p>$y = \frac{-3x - 7}{-4}$</p> <p>$\boxed{(-5, 2)}$</p>	<p>2. $\begin{cases} x - y = 27 \\ 2y = 6 - 3x \end{cases}$ HINT: Adjust the window.</p> <p>$y = x - 27$</p> <p>$y = 3 - \frac{3}{2}x$</p> <p>$\boxed{(12, -15)}$</p>
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II. Solving Linear Systems Algebraically. Solve each system by the indicated method.

<p>3. $\begin{cases} 6y - 2x = 6 \\ x = 3y + 3 \end{cases}$: substitution</p> <p>$6y = 2(3y + 3) - 6$</p> <p>$6y = 6y + 6 - 6$</p> <p>$0 = 0$ <i>Infinitely many solutions</i></p>	<p>4. $\begin{cases} 4x + 3y = 17 \\ 3x + 2y = 12 \end{cases}$: elimination</p> <p>$-8x - 6y = -34$ $4(2) + 3y = 17$</p> <p>$9x + 6y = 36$ $3y = 9$</p> <p>$x = 2$ $y = 3$</p> <p>$\boxed{(2, 3)}$</p>
<p>5. $\begin{cases} x - 2y = -8 \\ 3x + y = 4 \end{cases}$: your choice</p> <p>$6x + 2y = 8$</p> <p>$7x = 0$ $-2y = -8$</p> <p>$x = 0$ $y = 4$</p> <p>$\boxed{(0, 4)}$</p>	<p>6. $\begin{cases} y = 2x - 5 \\ 4x - 2y = 8 \end{cases}$: your choice</p> <p>$4x - 2(2x - 5) = 8$</p> <p>$4x - 4x + 10 = 8$</p> <p>$10 = 8$ NOPE!</p> <p>$\boxed{\text{No solution}}$</p>

III. Word Problems. Write a system to solve the word problem, but DO NOT SOLVE.

<p>7. Brian is 26 years older than his daughter Kim. The sum of their ages is twice the differences of their ages. Find their ages.</p> <p>Let $k =$ Kim's age $k + 26 =$ Brian's age</p> <p>$y_1 = k + k + 26 = 2k + 26$</p> <p>$y_2 = 2(k + 26 - k) = 52$</p> <p>$\boxed{k = 13}$ $\boxed{k + 26 = 39}$</p>	<p>8. Suppose a movie theater sold 200 adult and student tickets for a showing with a revenue of \$995. If the adult tickets were \$5.50 and the student tickets were \$4, how many of each type of ticket were sold?</p> <p>Let $x =$ # student tickets $y =$ # adult tickets</p> <p>$-4(x + y = 200) \rightarrow -4x - 4y = -800$</p> <p>$4x + 5.5y = 995 \rightarrow 4x + 5.5y = 995$</p> <p>$1.5y = 195$</p> <p>$\boxed{y = 130}$ $\boxed{x = 70}$</p>
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

IV. Compound and Absolute Value Inequalities. Solve and graph each inequality on a number line.

9. $x-3 > 2$ OR $2x-1 \leq 3$

$$x > 5 \text{ or } 2x \leq 4$$

$$x \leq 2$$




10. $1-2x < -3$ AND $15 > 3x$

$$-2x < -4 \text{ AND } 3x < 15$$

$$x > 2 \text{ AND } x < 5$$

$$2 < x < 5$$




11. $|2x+3| \geq 19$

$$2x+3 \geq 19 \text{ or } 2x+3 \leq -19$$

$$2x \geq 16 \quad 2x \leq -22$$

$$x \geq 8 \text{ or } x \leq -11$$

$$(-\infty, -11] \text{ or } [8, \infty)$$




12. $1-|2x| \geq -5$

$$-|2x| \geq -6$$

$$|2x| \leq 6$$

$$-6 \leq 2x \leq 6$$

$$-3 \leq x \leq 3$$



V. Absolute Value Equations. Solve each equation.

13. $|x+5| = 10$

$$x+5 = 10 \text{ or } x+5 = -10$$

$$x = 5 \text{ or } x = -15$$

14. $2|3n-2| = 24$

$$|3n-2| = 12$$

$$3n-2 = 12 \text{ or } 3n-2 = -12$$

$$3n = 14 \quad 3n = -10$$

$$n = \frac{14}{3} \text{ or } n = -\frac{10}{3}$$

15. $|5d-6| + 12 = 9$

$$|5d-6| = -3$$

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VI. Linear Regression.

16. Graph the data in a scatter plot on your graphing calculator using the mean distance from the sun as your independent variable.

Planet	Mercury	Venus	Earth	Mars	Jupiter	Saturn	Uranus	Neptune
Mean Distance from the sun (AU)	0.387	0.723	1.000	1.523	5.203	9.541	19.190	30.086
Time of one revolution (yr)	0.241	0.615	1.000	1.881	11.861	29.457	84.008	164.784

Correlation coefficient: .99 Line of Best Fit: $y = 5.395739804x - 7.618873117$

Predict the time of one revolution for Pluto if its mean distance from the sun is 39.507 AU. How accurate do you think your prediction is and WHY?

205.52 yr.

This is very accurate b/c the correlation coefficient shows a very strong positive correlation between the planet's distance from the sun and the time of revolution.
